How to access Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Outpatient Programs:

- The SUD Evaluation Clinic is located at the Eugene J. Towbin Medical Center, Bldg 170, Unit 3L. The clinic is open Monday-Friday 8:00am-2:00pm. Clinic is closed on Federal Holidays. No appointment is necessary. At this appointment, an APRN (Advanced Practice Registered Nurse) will complete an evaluation based on the Veteran's needs and a consult will be submitted according to what SUD program is recommended.

SUD Outpatient Program Options:

Intensive Outpatient Program (IOP)

- IOP is a 28-day treatment program that runs Monday through Friday from 8-11:30am, with the exception of holidays.
- Veteran can reside at Recovery Centers of Arkansas (RCA), this is where we have our housing contract, or their home. This program is offered as face to face and as VVC.
- Meals are provided if the Veteran is residing at RCA through the VA Dining Hall during the weekday. Meals during the weekend are provided through RCA.

Outpatient Recovery Program (ORP)

ORP is located on unit IK. Veterans can attend 1-2 groups a week based on their recovery needs. This is offered as face to face and through Veterans Virtual Care (VVC). You may be enrolled in one treatment group at a time. Any exceptions to this policy will be considered and approved on a case-by-case basis. This program is designed to provide treatment and support for up to two years.

Suboxone Treatment Program

If you are interested in the treatment of Opioid Use Disorder (OUD) with Suboxone (Buprenorphine/Naloxone), please present to the SUD Evaluation Clinic.

Medication Assisted Treatment

If you are interested in medication to help with cravings and withdrawal please contact unit 3L at 501-257-2846 or present to the SUD Evaluation Clinic. Cravings and withdrawal can be managed with medication and therapy.
